(11) History of Adam Trapler and his son Henry Trapler
Adam Trapler was the son of (Squire) Henry Trapler, a member of one of the older families of Pennsylvania, he was of German origin. When Adam was a lad his parent moved to the state of New York, there Adam was educated in the public schools and grew to manhood on the home farm. It was there he was united in marriage to Sylvia Roberts. Sylvia died 1864, Adam 1868.

Some years later they established their home in Pickland County, Ohio, where they later died and are buried. Mr. and Mrs. Adam Trapler were excellent people and highly regarded in the community.

At the time of the death of his father, Adam Henry Trapler was nineteen years old, the youngest of a family of seven children. Henry remained in Ohio for three years, then moved to Muscatine, County, Iowa, where he farmed for one year, while there he married Hannah E. Moore at West Liberty, Ia. Two sons, Edwin Clifford and Herbert William were born here. In 1879 they came by covered wagon to Kansas and established their home in Barton County. They homesteaded a tract of land for a time living in a dugout or sod house. Here the little family experienced many of the hardships of pioneer life on the plains. In 1882 they moved to Brown County where they lived for one year, in 1883 they came to Marshall County where they lived in Logan township southwest of Marysville. They then took up their residence in Herkimer Township and purchased a good farm there, Mr. Trapler engaged in general farming until 1891, here Claude and Robert were born, a few years later a farm was purchased in Waterville township and also in Cottage Hill township where Ralph and Stanley were born. Mr. Trapler owned four hundred and eighty acres of splendid land most of which was under a high state of

cultivation and well improved. He erected a (2)⁽²⁾
beautiful ten room modern house in 1911, with
hot water heat, full bath, hardwood floors, Carbide
gas lighting, every convenience possible. He
had a splendid barn with silo for housing of his
stock and grain. He was much interested in his
Red Poll cattle and Duroc Jersey hogs. He kept
all buildings in fine repair and the place beauti-
ful with trees, shrubbery, a nice orchard and green
lawns.

The Henry Traplers were active members of
the Methodist Episcopal church, prominent in
the social life of the community in which they
lived, held in high esteem and regard by all.

Politically, Mr. Trapler was a Republican
and while he took much interest in local affairs
he was not an office seeker.

Henry's father, Adam and five brothers
all came to this country from Europe most
of them settled in New York state. Henry had
three sisters, Mary Jane, Elizabeth, and France,
two brothers, Lester and Herman, who was killed
in the Civil War.

Hannah E. Moore, who married Henry William⁽³⁾ Trapler, Sept. 1, 1870, was the daughter of Jackson Moore and Mina C. Irvin, who were married Jan. 12, 1847. Hannah Elizabeth was born near, Mansfield, Ohio, Nov. 26, 1850, her father Jackson Moore was born Dec. 20, 1820 and her mother, Mina C. Irvin, May 5, 1820. They were the parents of eight children: 1.
