Amaziah R. Frantz of 534 Malaga street, passed away at his home at 7:30 o'clock Saturday evening, at the age of sixty years, one month and fourteen days.

He is survived by his widow, Ethel: one son, C. E. Frantz of Waverly, Wash., and six daughters, Mrs. Pearl Davis, Portland; Mrs. Bertha Marriott, Mayetta, Kan.; Mrs. Clara Meyer, Sioux City, Ia.; Mrs. Georgia Piton, Manson, and Mrs. Ruby Armstrong and Mrs. Verna Dull of Wenatchee.

The deceased has seven brothers, five of whom reside in North Manchester, Ind. they are: Josiah, Cyrus, Manias, Estie and Esli, John H lives at Tecumseh, Mich., and Ezra at Milan, Wash. Ezra is the only brother who will be able to be in attendance the funeral. Mr. Frantz also leaves 14 grandchildren.

He was a member of the Brethren church of Sunnyslope and the funeral is being held there this afternoon at 2 o'clock with the Rev. Strycker and Ulrich in charge of the services.

Jones and Jones had charge of the funeral arrangements. Interment is to be in the Sunnyslope cemetery. Mr. Frantz was a resident of the valley for twenty-one years

FRANTZ, Laura Jane (Baker), was born in Frederick County, Md., April 24, 1867, and died at her home in Wenatchee, Wash., Feb. 4, 1925, aged 57 years, 9 months and 20 days. At he age of eight years she moved with her parents to North Manchester, Ind., where she grew to womanhood. In 1884 she united with the Church of the Brethren. On Feb. 29, 1888, she was married to Amaziah F. Frantz. In 1896 they left Indiana for North Dakota, where they lived until 1906, when they moved to Wenatchee, Wash. She was the mother of one son and six daughters, all of whom, with her husband and nine grandchildren, survive.

She was tender, kind, sympathetic and faithful in every avenue of loving service. She served for a number of years with her husband in the office of deacon. Funeral services in the Sunnyslope church, conducted by Eld., W. A. Deardorff and Eld. R. F. Hiner. Interment in adjoining cemetery. - Mrs. W. A. Deardorff, Wenatchee, Wash.

Besides her husband, she leaves six daughters, Mrs. Pearl Davis, of Leavenworth: Mrs. Bertha Marriott, of Mayette, Kansas; Mrs. A. O. Meyer, of Sioux City, Iowa; Mrs. D. C. Pittman of Manson; Mrs. D. C. Armstrong of Seattle and Miss Verna Frantz of Wenatchee. One son, Clarence E. Frantz, lives at Waverly, Wash. Five brothers and one sister, all residing in Wabash county, Indiana, and 13 living grandchildren also survive her.

The deceased has been a member of the Brethren church since 1884 and has resided in the Wenatchee valley for 19 years.

The funeral will occur Thursday February 5, at 2 p. m. from the Brethren church of Sunnyslope, Elders W. A. Deardorff and R. T. Hiner, officiating. Interment in the Sunnyslope cemetery, the Wenatchee Undertaking company in charge.
