II Magdalene Zug, page 2, was a sister to the writer's great grandfather. She was born ---- and was married to Michael Frantz Jr. who was born in Germany about the year 1728 and immigrated to America with his father at the age of about two years. Some time after their marriage (time not known) they moved from Lancaster County to Estatourt County, Va., where they sattled dow when she died was not to be had. Her husband, Michael Frantz, died about the year 1810, aged about 82 years. She was the mother of eight sons and one daughter:

These names may not be in the proper rotation, but in this order they were obtained from Elder Aaron Frantz of Dialton, Clark County, Ohio. (See page 75) He was a grandson of III Christian Frantz. Magdalena's genealogy is numeraus, but the writer failed to obtain the half of them.

III Christian Frantz, above, a cousin to the writer's grandfather, was born about the year 1766 and was married to Mary Carst who was born ----. He moved from Botetourt County, Va. (time not known) to Clark County, Chio. He was an elder of the German Haptist Brethren Church and had charge of the Donnels Creek Church in said county, where he died March 6, 1850, aged about. By years. His wife, Mary, died August 8, 1838, aged ----. He had two sons and seven daughters:

His father, Michael Frantz Sr. was baptized Soptember 29, 1734 together with 19 others by the German Baptist Brethren Church in Lancaster County, Pa, He became the first minister and elder of the Conestoga and White Oak Church of Lancaster County. He died in said county in the year of 1748. (From the Gospel Visitor, volume 5, no. 3, page 58, under the heading of "The very Ancient Church of the Brethren in Lancaster County, Pa.") The said Michael Frantz Sr. arrived at Philadelphia either September 30, 1727 (only 3 days after Ulric Zug) with the Ship, Molley, John Hodgoson, Master, from Rotterdam or August 11, 1732 with the Ship Samuel of London. The latter ship had also a Johannes Frantz on board. The writer's informant, Elder Aaron Frantz, was of the opinion that he came to America in 1730. But as the two sais ships were the only ships recorded in I. Daniel Rupp's history of immigrants that had Frantz' aboard is conclusive evidence that he arrived either in one or the other. After Elder Aaron Frantz had been informed of this fact, then he upon due meditation concluded that the said Michael Frantz Jr. was born about 1725 instead of 1728 as shown above and came over in 1727 with the Ship Molley.

VI Clara I. Della Myers, above, was a student at Mount Morris College while the writer's daughter, Mary, was there in 1893-94 and they were very intimate friends. She had also furnished most of the record above. Her husband, Rev. Lewis R. Peiffer, is also a minister in the German Baptist Brethren and was first married to Lydia Deppen (a second cousin to the writer) who was born in Berks County, Pa., died in Waterloo, Iowa and left two children. V Aaron Frantz, page 74, was married to Mary Ryman. They live in Dialton, Clark County, Ohio. He is a minister of the Gospel in the Brethren(now known as the 'Old Order') He, it is, from whom the writer obtained the first information of Michael and Magdalena Zug Frantz' family (they were his great grand-parents). His letter, no. 14, reached the writer September 13, 1883. He has a family of ten children:

He had a family of six children: V John Frantz, V Andrew Frantz, V David Frantz, V Lydia Frantz, V Mary Frantz and V Anna Frantz.

IV Mary Frantz, page 74, was born January 23, 1793 and died at the residence of her son in law in Bachelor's Run Church in Carroll County, Indiana on Tuesday, November 2, 1375, aged 82 years, 9 months and 9 days. She was married to John Brubaker who died in Freble County, Ohio in 1848. She was the mother of nine children and a member of the Brethren Church over sixty years. Three of her sons are deacons in the church.

Find Daniel Frantz, page 73, son of Michael and Magdalena Zug Frantz was raised in Botetourt County, Va., whence he moved about the year 1813 to near Springfield, Ohio (Clark County). There he lived and died, when is not known. He was married twice; first to Anna Girst, born ----, died in Clark County, Of this second wife was a widow, Magdalena Minick (maiden name Garver) with whom he had three children: IV Joel, IV Sally and IV Elizabeth of whom nothing is known. V. Jacob Frantz, above, was married to ----. He lives in Dayton, Ohio where the writer had met him in the meeting on Sunday, June 3, 1903. He was once a minister of the Frethren Church. I wrote to him for certain information out no reply. However, later (November 23, 1903) the said letter was answered by his brother, Benjamin C. Frantz, (see no. 370), which was however not very definite as may be seen.

V Benjamin C. Frantz, above, resides at New Carisle, Chio. He was married e; first to Mary Ann Leedy, daughter of John and Elizabeth Leedy. She was born in Wabash County, Indiana September 6, 1838 and died in Clark County, Chio August 9, 1896 and left to survive nine children. He married as his second wife a --- Binkley of Lancaster County, Pa. He was the writer's informant under date of November 23, 1903 (letter no. 370)

V Elder Henry Frantz, page 76, was born 1 1/2 miles east of Carisle, Clark County, Ohio and was an elder in the German Baptist Brethren Church. He moved in 1890 to Forgy, same county, whence he removed in 1891 to Surrey, North Dakota where he died May 18, 1904, aged 61 years, 4 months and 20 days. He had four children, two of whom died in infancy. The two surviving are:

VI Edward Frantz who is President of McPherson College in Kansas; VI Florence Frantz, married to ---- Drasher, living at Surrey, North Dakota.

III David Frantz, page 73, son of Michael and Magdalena Zug Frantz, was married to (not known any more to whom). He died in Virginia when he was between 45 and 50 years as near as it was known. He had six sons and two daughters:

V David Frantz, above, was born in Franklin County, Virginia whence he moved in August 1866 to near Dawson, West Virginia, where he died March 30, 1904, aged 83 years, 2 months and 25 days. He was married twice (strange the names of his wives were not obtained). He was the father of nineteen nine of whom preceded him. His last wife, Sarah, preceded him only 11 months and 9 days.

VI Elder Abraham M. Frantz of Dawson, West Virginia is one of his sons. He was born October 29, 1359 in Franklin County, Virginia, which place he left with his father at the age of seven years and settled where his father died. Part of these few pages were obtained by him under date of March 7, 1904 (see letter no. 373). This is not as definite as it was desired.
