70 YEARS, DIES**

**Uremic Poisoning Is Fatal To
Nonagenarian; Funeral
Is Wednesday**

John Swartz, aged 95 years, one of Kendallville's oldest residents, died Sunday at 12:15 p.m., at the home of his son, Harry Swartz, Wood street, of uremic poisoning. He had been in falling health since February, but was bedfast for only the past two weeks.

He was born September 6, 1848, in Wappokenetta, O., where he spent his early childhood. He later moved to Indiana and made his home in Kendallville for the last 70 years. For several years, resided with his son, Harry.

He was united in marriage to Laura Eldena Octon, in 1876, in Sturgis, Mich. To this union were born 11 children, six sons and five daughters.

For many years he worked as a mason and later as a truck gardener.

Surviving are five sons, Harry, Charles, James and Earl of this city and William of Wawaka; two daughters Mrs. Ellen Duncan Everett, O., and Mrs. Pearl Warble, R.R., Kendallville. A sister, Mrs. Belle Maxham, Benton Harbor, Mich., also survives. There are 31 grandchildren and 26 great-grandchildren. The wife, three daughters and one son preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be held at the A. J. Berhalter company funeral home Wednesday at 2:30 p.m., Rev. H. W. Mount of the Church of Christ, officiating. Interment, Lakeview cemetery.
