Das Bürgerprotokollbuch der Gemeinde Lamsheim nennt bei Zuwanderungen oft, aber nicht immer, den Herkunftsort. Meist jedoch fehlen Beruf, Alter und Familienstand, immer die Konfession. Die Kirchenbücher beginnen erst um 1700. Sie weisen große Lücken auf, so daß auch für die Zeit nach 1700 nicht alle wünschenswerten Daten beizubringen sind. Immerhin kann festgestellt werden, ob der Name in Lamsheim ausgestorben ist oder nicht. Die Protokollbücher und Rechnungen enthalten Angaben, die über die Lebensverhältnisse der Einwanderer Auskunft geben.

Mit der vorliegenden Liste dürfte eine große Zahl der Zuwanderer aus der Schweiz und anderen Nachbarländern für die genannte Zeit erfaßt sein. Viele Namen verschwinden wieder nach kurzer Zeit. Nur denen, die einen festen Beruf hatten, wie Schmiede, Schuhmacher, Maurer u. a., gelang es in der Regel ansässig zu werden und zu Vermögen und Ansehen zu kommen. Von den folgenden fünfzig Namens-trägern ist es rund ein Fünftel.

to present Edward Township. About the same time, Thomas [unclear] and some of his brothers settled along Dunkard Creek. [unclear] and members of his family came to Red- [unclear] [unclear]. Two years later his sons William and David moved [unclear] river, one making tomahawk improvements on lands along [unclear] to present Greene County, the other on lands along [unclear] between Millstoro and Clarksville. Settling on Muddy [unclear] in 1767 were John Swan and Thomas Hughes, and in 1768, Henry [unclear]. However much the purpose and length of stay of the [unclear] filterings into the region may be obscured, there is no [unclear] that by the end of the 1760's the earliest communities were started.

Since many of the earliest settlers were loyal to Virginia, it may be of value to know the region's organization under that [unclear]. Orange County was erected in 1734 out of Spottsylvania [unclear]. The erection of Augusta County out of Orange took place between 1738 and 1745. The Augusta County Court adjourned from Staunton to Fort Dunmore (Pittsburgh) on 12 December 1774 where the West Augusta District was created in October 1776. The District was subdivided into three counties, Yohogania, Monongalia, and Ohio. The eastern two-thirds of Greene County were included in Monongalia County, the western third in Ohio County. Monongalia chose the plantation of Theophilus Phillips, about two miles above New Geneva on the Monongahela River, as the site for holding its courts. After establishment of the boundry line, the courts were moved to the plantation of Zackwell Morgan in Morgantown. Unfortunately, the early records of this court were lost in the burning of the clerk's office in 1796. The Ohio County courts were held at Black's Cabin on Short Creek from 6 January 1777 until 1797 when it was moved to Wheeling. Both Monongalia and Ohio Counties were included in West Virginia when it was formed in 1863.

When Cumberland County was erected on 27 January 1750 under the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it embraced all lands lying west of the Susquehanna River and north and west of the County of York. All of present Greene County was included as a part of Springhill Township, a subdivision of Bedford County, which was erected out of Cumberland on 9 March 1771. The area remained a part of Springhill Township under Westmoreland County when the latter was formed from Bedford County on 26 February 1773.

Washington County, upon its erection out of Westmoreland on 28 March 1781, laid out thirteen townships. General, Cumberland, Morgan, and Greene Townships composed the portion which is now Greene County. While under the jurisdiction of Washington County, Franklin Township was formed from Morgan and Cumberland Townships in 1786; Finley Township was taken from General Township in January 1788; and in March 1792 Richhill Township was erected out of Finley.

Assessment Rolls of Washington County for townships existing in 1784-5 and 1793 have been published and may be found in Dr.

## An 1883 Funeral at Millersville<sup>1</sup>

August 2, 1883: Rain in the forenoon; clear in the afternoon. I attended the funeral rites of Mary Kendig, wife of Christ Kendig,<sup>2</sup> at the Old Mennonite Church, east of Millersville. Her age was 68 years, 4 months and 9 days. In February, 1838, she was married, and during her matrimonial engagement she was blessed with nine children—two sons and seven daughters. Two of the daughters are dead. Bishop Amos Sherk and Rev. J. K. Brubaker officiated in their ministerial functions. The appropriate text we find in Luke, 10th chapter, and the 42nd verse: "But one thing is needful and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken from her." The Scriptural explanation thereof gave good evidence that the deceased friend had chosen the same as Mary, the friend of Jesus, to sit at her Saviour's feet, which gives fair hope of her entrance to eternal life, with good hope, providing her husband and children continue in the same Christian life, that they will all meet in that blessed home where separations never take place.

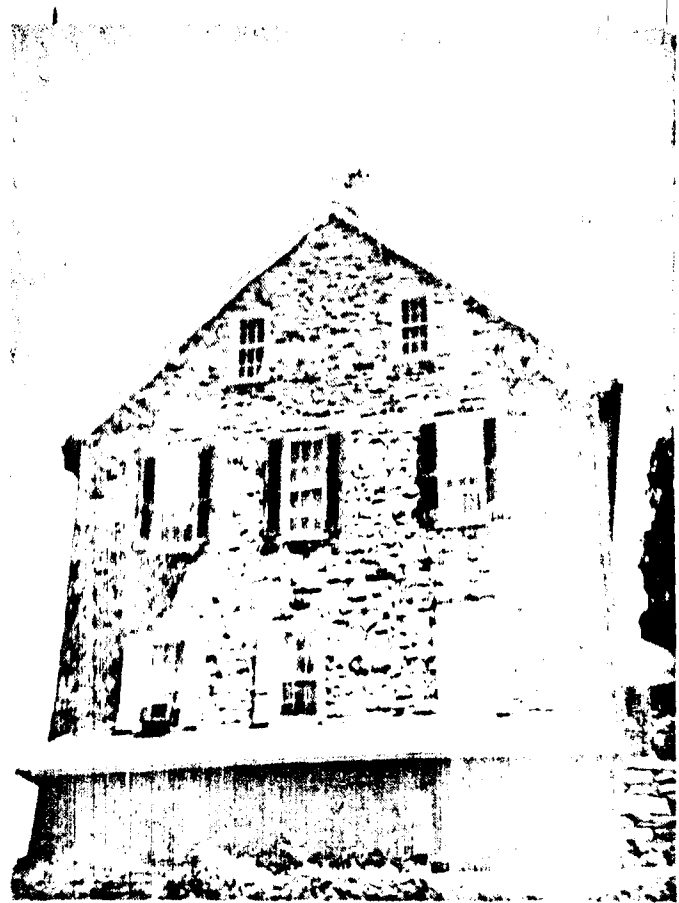

### The Kendig Home

This was a part of the Conestoga Manor of the Penns. Jacob Frantz obtained it in 1735 and confirmed it by a 1740 patent (S 86). In 1785, John France, Manor, sold one hundred sixty-six acres to Jacob France in Id (EE 126). In 1803, John and Christian Frantz, Executors of Jacob Frantz, Lampeter, sold to John Frantz, Jr., Manor, in Manor (N 3 339, 359). Johannes Frantz, (Sept. 1781-Nov. 1838), son of Jacob-Barbara Hostetter, married Elizabeth Brubaker, Mar. 7, 1789-Jan. 28, 1848, dsp. The house was built by Johannes and Elizabeth Frantz in 1835. The barn on the farm along the lane near Millersville, was built by John B. Frantz, (1812-1881), married Susan Miller, (1818-1894), in 1860.

In 1867, Dr. Samuel B. Hartman bought the one hundred nineteen acres. During the Civil War days, a \$65,000 mort-

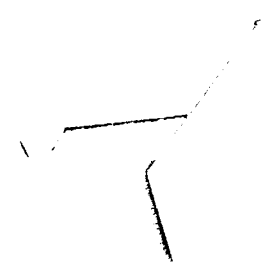

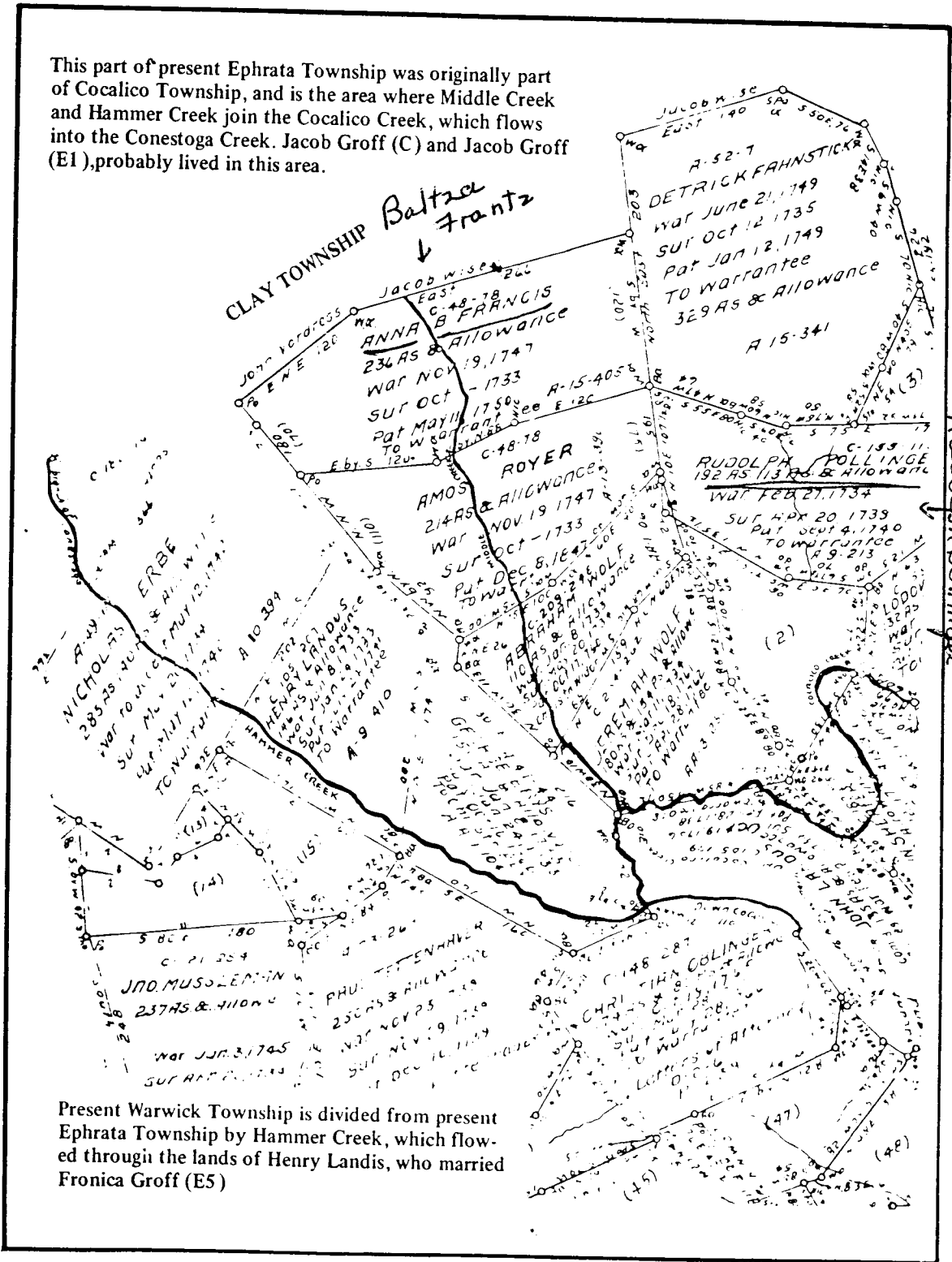
