What I copied from the "History of the LONG Family of PA", Pub by Long Family Organization of PA, 1930:

Christian LANG (~1664 - 1762) to Herman LANG (~1700 - 1773) to Christian LANG (didn't get dates) to Herman LANG (5 Jul 1748-1820):
 [you don't have this Herman listed as child of Christian & Ann HERSHEY. Book notes that Herman rec'd part of original tract purchased by father, Christian LANG from his grandfather Herman LANG who rec'd patent for same on 5 June 1740.]

Son of Herman LANG: John LANG 10 Jun 1777-5 Jul 1856. m 1. Elizabeth DAY (1787-17 Nov 1821) and 2. Elizabeth GARMAN, widow (3 Mar 1798-7 Feb 1858)
 John LANG lived on "Old" Jacob LONG farm southeast of Annville (Fairlands area), originally deeded to John LONG by Peter FORNEY 15 Nov 1826.
 Elizabeth's parents, John & Elizabeth, are buried there.

Son of John LANG & Elizabeth DAY: Jacob LONG (19 Oct 1820 - 19 Oct 1894) m Elizabeth BROWN (1 Apr 1819 - 21 Jun 1888).

**Sarah (15 Jan 1841 - 11 May 1916) m William Deitzler MILLER (this is my husband's g-g-grandfather!!)
