# Old Order Notes

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## THE AUSBUND

Illustration: The *Ausbund* is the oldest hymnbook of the Swiss Brethren and is still used by the Amish in North America. Pictured is a later enlarged edition of over 800 pages, now in the library of the editor of *Old Order Notes*, and was published in "Germantown: Printed by Leibert and Billmeyer, 1785," successors to the Sower Press. The first American edition was printed in 1742 by Christopher Sower. The earliest edition known dates 1564. (Only known copy of this smaller earliest edition is in the Goshen College Library). Fifty-one hymns were written by a number of Anabaptists in the dungeons of the castle of Passau on the Danube in Bavaria. Many were later martyred. "The (oldest) hymns . . . represent very characteristically the spirit of 16th century Anabaptism (Swiss Brethren), namely, the conviction that their church is a "suffering church" in a relentless world, and that martyrdom is the fate of earnest Christians everywhere. The dominant tone is one of great sorrow, deep loneliness, and protest against a world of wickedness. Yet there is no despair but rather a note of triumph: God will not forsake His own. Among the best-known hymns is No. 131: "O Gott Vater, wir loben Dich und deine Gute preisen," still sung today by the Amish at the beginning of every worship service."

# Old German Baptist Brethren Ministers

## Centennial List 1881-1981

The following centennial ministerial list is the most complete list of Old German Baptist Brethren ministers known to this author. The research of several lists available was undertaken in preparation for the forthcoming *Brethren Encyclopedia*. We began by searching the ministerial lists published in *The Vindicator*, an unpublished ministerial list found among the papers of John M. Kimmel, the Memorial Ministerial List by Kimmel in *The Vindicator* for 1921, and ministerial lists from the 1884 and 1887 editions of *Our Almanac*, printed by James Quinter. Additions were made from the text of *The Vindicator*. We progressed well when we became aware of a ministerial list maintained over the years by brother Elbert Baker of Lakeland, Florida. This list greatly shortened the work which we had begun but didn't exactly fit our needs since it was in chronological order of election to office and not alphabetical. Sources used in the current list are further described below.

**OUR ALMANAC**—This almanac was published by James Quinter and we had in our possession copies of the 1884 and 1887 issues. The dependability of some of these early ministerial lists is in question both as to names included and spelling. The lists are stated to be partial and included only name, post office, county and state. It is interesting to note that some of these editions contained material needed and some did not. "To satisfy some fastidious persons" who might be offended by their inclusion, some editions omitted the "old order" (Old German Baptist) and the "new order" (Progressive or Congregational) lists.

**MINISTERIAL LISTS FROM VINDICATORS BEFORE 1901**—Ministerial lists were published intermittently during this period. Dates include 1887 (pp. 186, 354), 1890 (p. 185), 1891 (p. 187), 1894 (pp. 285, 320), and 1899 (p. 212). In 1901 and thereafter the ministerial lists were published in the November issue. These lists include errors in names included and spelling but are valuable sources.

**MEMORIAL MINISTERIAL LIST**—This was published in *The Vindicator* in 1921 (p. 313) and lists Old German Baptist Brethren ministers who had died previously with their place and year of birth and death and their office at the time of death. The list is not complete but is very good.

**REGISTER OF DECEASED MINISTERS**—This is an unpublished list by John M. Kimmel found in his private papers and now in the posses-

sion of brother Fred Benedict. The list is incomplete and in places inaccurate but quite helpful. Names are listed both alphabetically and by year of election to office.

OLD GERMAN BAPTIST BRETHERN MINISTERS AND DEACONS—This is an eight page pamphlet published periodically by brother Willie R. Flora of Brookville, Ohio and is complete and quite accurate for living ministers and deacons.

MINISTERIAL LIST (UNPUBLISHED) BY ELBERT BAKER—This list, maintained by brother Elbert Baker over the years, is quite extensive and certainly the most complete until the current list. Wherever the information is available, it lists names, rank in office, day, month and year of birth, death and election to the office of visit (deacon), ministry, advancement, and eldership. When out of office during life or at death this is also indicated. The list is given by year of election to the ministry although an alphabetical index is also included.

After a tentative list was completed and the type set, proofs were sent to approximately 450 Old German Baptists and about 11% responded with corrections and comments. We tried to confirm this additional input as best we could and came up with the present list.

Problems met in compiling this list were many. Early lists were incomplete and spelling was poor. The incompleteness is evident when one compares the list from *Our Almanac* for 1887 with that in *The Vindicator* for the same year. Many dates in Elbert Baker's list do not correspond with the dates in Willie Flora's and John Kimmel's lists. Obituaries, which one would expect to be the most accurate, contain errors and contradict themselves occasionally on dates. Brother Elbert Baker included thirty-three ministers which we did not have on our original list and our list included twenty-five omitted by Elbert Baker. John P. Ebersole was included on the Baker list and we find no evidence that he ever joined the Old Brethren. John Kimmel included David Murray who was a signer of the Painter Creek Resolutions of August 21, 1881 but who later retracted his name and did not further identify with the Old Orders. These two men are excluded from the current list until further evidence can be obtained.

We have included at the end of the list the names of several men who were identified at least once somewhere as a minister but for whom there is contradictory or insufficient dependable evidence. Brother Elbert Baker did not include a name if there were not two sources identifying the name as a minister. We felt that such should be listed as ministers but be identified as having limited supportive evidence. An example of contradictory evidence is the case of Christian Gascho. Both the *Our Almanac* and *The Vindicator* lists included this name but the obituary identifies this man as being a visit brother (deacon).

This list is incomplete and undoubtedly contains inaccuracies. Written comments from anyone who can help to improve the list are welcome. We hope the list will serve as a valuable help to anyone in genealogical and historical study and several people who knew that we were working on the list have made use of our material already.

We wish to thank those who contributed, especially brothers Elbert Baker and Willie Flora. We also appreciated the time and effort of all those who replied to the proofs sent out several months ago.

# Wherefore?

Who split from whom in the Old Order Brethren Divide of 1881?

(Answered by the editor of *Old Order Notes*)

A friend from Indiana asks the editor this question. The facts in the case are interesting. The old order-minded folk brought the first petition to the Annual Meeting of 1869. Other efforts to bring the German Baptist church back to "the old foundations" took place in the next ten years. When a petition in 1880 and another in 1881 failed to gain satisfaction, a Special Conference was called in August 24, 1881 at the Ludlow and Painter Creek Church near Arcanum, Ohio. At this conference resolutions were passed outlining the grievances felt by the Old Orders and their resolves to adhere to the old traditions. They said, "we feel to be led no further in this popular current." The last paragraph contains these words:

. . . "Now, after this resolution is accepted, we advise all our members be counseled in every church in the Valley, and in all other districts in our brotherhood that unite with us. Do the same to get the minds of the members. And we advise that two faithful and impartial elders be present at those councils, as we want nothing but honesty and fairness. But first, before any council is gone into, the members should be well instructed and enlightened in every point, showing no partiality nor forbidding brethren to give their opinion in love on both sides. After the members are well enlightened, let each member express his own mind, that a fair decision may be made; so we can learn how many will stand united to the ancient order of our church. And if some should ask time to consider, let it be granted them. To such the door of the church is open. But such as will express themselves not willing to stand united with the ancient order of our church, we could not help them, and if they would afterwards change their minds and wish to unite with us, they will then have to enter legally according to order. But such as will not stand united with us in the apostolic order of our church, *would then have to be disfellowshipped from the old brethren's church.*"

(Italics supplied)

In the ensuing discussion, before adopting the resolutions, it was well understood that whoever voted for these resolutions would "absent themselves from the then acknowledged Annual Meeting." Then "a rising vote was taken and a large number of members, of both brethren and sisters, rose up in favor of the resolutions being adopted, and it was so."

So far, two outstanding facts emerge: (a) our italic words above show that the Old Orders aimed to disfellowship all who would not agree with the resolutions and (b) those present at the Special Conference, by their acceptance of the resolutions, repudiated the authority of the German Baptist Annual Meeting. The Old Orders were defining the church in their own terms (old order) and would disfellowship all who disagreed. By rejecting Annual Meeting authority, they separated themselves from the large body of the church.

But, all this did not happen quite as planned. We quote from the *Brethren's Reasons* written by Samuel Kinsey, Samuel Murray and George V. Siler: "But instead

# Genealogy

## VIELBRUNN—"many springs"

The Filbrun family can trace their roots to the early 1500's in Germany. The name Fillbrunn first appeared in official records in 1570 when Peter Fillbrunn of Neckerhausen paid rent to the ancient Catholic Monastery of Schonau.

In early times when a person moved from one area to another, he often became known by the name of his previous home. Thus, our first ancestor came from Vielbrunn, an ancient village in the Odenwald Mountains of Baden, West Germany. In German the name Vielbrunn means "many springs" and today the area is still a health resort. (In German the letter "v" is pronounced with the English sound "f".) Peter of Vielbrunn moved to Neckerhausen about 20 miles from the village of Vielbrunn.

The Fillbrunn record is found in Germany for nearly 300 years before our immigrant came to America. Many of these Fillbrunn were mayors or postmasters. Because writing skills, not common in those days, were required for these offices, and the offices were hereditary, a fairly complete record exists containing names, births, deaths, marriage, and their dates. Thus, the Filbrun family can be traced for 16 generations.

The weekend of July 12-13, 1980 was a special occasion for the Filbrun Family. Mr. and Mrs. Daniel Filbrun of near West Manchester, Ohio hosted the Filbrun reunion at their farm commemorating the 150th anniversary of the year the Filbruns first set foot in Ohio. Word was spread throughout the U.S. and Filbruns from Germany were present. Burgermeister (Mayor) George Mengler of Vielbrunn, West Germany, sent greetings and an invitation to all to visit their native village.

Peter of Vielbrunn, the first known ancestor of the American Filbrun family, was the great, great-grandfather of Alexander Mack, founder of the German Baptist Brethren. Mack was named after an uncle, Alexander Phillbrunn. Mack's mother was Christina Phillbrunn.

In 1818, for unknown reasons, Johann Peter Filbrun, the 5th generation from our first known ancestor, came to America. He was 21 years of age and settled in the Shenandoah Valley, Virginia. He lived in an agricultural community of the German Baptist Brethren of which he, his wife and a large percentage of his descendants became members.

After coming to America Peter dropped "Johann" from his name and spelled his name Filbrun, as it is still spelled today. Peter married Eliza-

beth Harshbarger, daughter of Henry and Elizabeth (Reinhart) Harshbarger, in 1822. Three sons, Joseph, John, and Henry, were born to them in Rockingham Co., Virginia.

In 1829 a group of 16, including Peter's family of five, Henry Harshbarger and wife, Daniel Arnold and wife (a sister of Peter's wife) and children, and Jacob Snell's family moved west in oxen-pulled wagons. They settled on the farm now known as the "Carriage Hill Farm" in Montgomery Co., Ohio and is operated by Dayton-Montgomery Co. Park District. A few months later Peter purchased a farm in Harrison Township.

Peter and Elizabeth were members of the Hickory Grove German Baptist church also known as the Upper Miami church in the 1860's. After the division of 1881 this church was known as Maple Grove. They had three sons, 20 grandsons and eight granddaughters. Four grandsons and three granddaughters died as infants.

The first son, Joseph, married Lydia Frantz, daughter of Benjamin and Elizabeth (Flory) Frantz and they had 15 children as follows: Elizabeth married Peter Brubaker and lived in Kansas; Jacob married Nancy Beckner and lived in Indiana; Sarah married Elder Moses Plunkett and lived in Kansas; Henry H. married Sarah Denlinger, lived in Ohio and had a second marriage to Mary Miller; Isaac D. married Mary Otwald and lived in Illinois; Lavina married Abraham Bowman, with a second marriage to Mike Flory and lived in Illinois; Jonah F. married Susan Garst and lived in California; Benjamin F. married Alice Denlinger and lived in Illinois; Joseph J. married Elizabeth Brubaker and lived in California (Benjamin and Joseph were both ministers in the Church of the Brethren); Peter F. married Luella Whitehorn and lived by Lower Twin church near Eaton, Ohio; Martin married Mary Elizabeth Smith and lived near Dayton, Ohio; Levi married Cora Crain and lived in Illinois; Daniel F. married Elizabeth Filbrun with a second marriage to Clara Foutz and lived at Ft. Loramie, Ohio; and two sons died in infancy.

The second son, John, married Lydia Heck, a cousin of Joseph's wife, daughter of Peter and Anna Frantz Heck. John was a deacon at Maple Grove church. They had nine children; Peter married Caroline Dietrich, Elizabeth married William Whistler, John, Jr. married Elizabeth Brenner, David S. married Sarah Karns (David was a minister with the Church of the Brethren), Mary married Abraham Garber. The other four children died young.

The third son, Henry, married Elizabeth Frantz from Clark Co., Ohio and they had four sons: Samuel married Althea Neff, Joseph married Hettie Neff, Daniel married Sarah J. Garber, George never married.

The immigrant (Johann) Peter's wife Elizabeth died in 1856 and he married Barbara Overholzer. Peter died in 1873, Barbara in 1882. Peter and Elizabeth, John and Lydia and John's four children are all buried in the Maple Grove church cemetery. Henry died in 1871 and is buried at Bear Creek church cemetery, near New Lebanon, Ohio. Joseph was killed when his horse and buggy was hit by a train in 1889. He was a minister, advanced to the second degree of office. He is buried at the Stillwater church cemetery, near Dayton, Ohio. John died in 1896.

Several Filbruns have hosted the Brethren Annual Meetings on their farms. Joseph Filbrun in 1874, John Filbrun in 1885, Henry H. Filbrun in 1904 and Floyd Filbrun in 1960.

There are approximately 2,000 Filbruns in America while there are only 18 Filbruns in West Germany. It is believed that all the Filbruns in the U.S. today are descended from (Johann) Peter Filbrun.

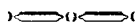

## Reviews

*Conscience in Crisis.* Richard K. MacMaster with Samuel L. Horst and Robert F. Ulle. Herald Press, Scottdale, Pa. and Kitchener, Ontario, 1979. 576 pages. \$17.95 (In Canada \$20.80) Cloth.

Now we have it! A thorough study of the experiences of the peace churches during the Colonial Wars and the American Revolution. *Conscience in Crisis* by Richard K. MacMaster with Samuel L. Horst and Robert F. Ulle, volume No. 20 in the distinguished series, "Studies in Anabaptist and Mennonite History" was published last year by Herald Press. MacMaster, Associate Professor of History at James Madison University, Harrisonburg, Virginia is responsible for most of the writing. Samuel L. Horst is a professor of history at Eastern Mennonite College and Robert F. Ulle is a doctoral candidate at the University of Pennsylvania. Much of the story of the Mennonites, Amish, Friends, Brethren, Schwenkfelders, Moravians, Methodists and other nonresistant people during this period have been a blank page until now—but no longer! Except for the well-known story of Christopher Sower II, little from this period of history has been published.

From official records including state and local records and revolutionary bodies such as the Continental Congress, state conventions, and many local committees; British Headquarters papers of Sir Henry Clinton, Christopher Sauer III, William Rankin, Sir Guy Carleton, Cornwallis and others; church records in Amish and Mennonite congregations such as alms books, records of deacons, school accounts; sermons and religious writings in the Schwenkfelder Library, the Moravian Archives, Quaker Collections, Brethren Annual Meeting Minutes; personal papers such as those of C. Grubb, William Henry, Shippen Family, Christopher Marshall, Conrad Weiser and others; newspapers, both English and German, published in Philadelphia and Germantown; pamphlets and other sources, these authors have selected 339 documents relating directly to the sufferings of members of the peace churches for conscience sake.

This reviewer is especially pleased with the quality and quantity of editorial work serving to give background and clarification of the problems confronting all parties in the tumultuous times. The Introduction states succinctly the paradox of a sectarian state—"the instruments of political power had been in Quaker hands from the beginning of the colony." The overall theme of the book is the story of how, from "necessity," the secular forces took over the state and finally disenfranchised the sectarians and persecuted them for a time, not only in Pennsylvania, but in New Jersey, Maryland, Virginia, and North Carolina.

In the years preceding the Revolutionary War the Quaker dominated Pennsylvania government in Philadelphia refused to enact legislation permitting the state to gather and equip a militia for its protection. These years saw a witch's brew—English demands for money for foreign wars; an uncooperative Quaker government; official betrayal of the Delaware Indians; Indian retaliatory raids; pressure from the populace for an army; pressure from nonresistants against forming an army; French and Indians against the settlers; settlers up in arms; a riot in Philadelphia against the Quakers; rioting whites massacring peaceful Indians—all this as a prelude to the Revolutionary War.

Is the individual Christian responsible for the actions of his government in a free society, and how far can nonresistant people cooperate with the state in wartime? The modern problems of the relation of the sectarian churches to the state "derives
