If you have "roots" in LaVerne, you may have family buried in the LaVerne Evergreen Cemetery.

Tombstone Inscriptions was compiled by E. Louise Larick (a well-known long time resident of Laverne) and Lorraine Frantz Edwards (genealogy hobbyist) [both] with several family members interred in the cemetery.

The 8-1/2" x 11" soft cover book contains 270 pages including a 65 page every-name Index of more than 3400 individuals. As the title suggests, all information on the tombstone is documented. Additionally, those interred who served in the armed forces of the Confederate, Civil, Spanish American, World War One, World War Two, Korea and Vietnam are identified in a special section devoted to Veterans. The History of the cemetery, Maps and numerous Pictures enhance the publication.
