"ye 30th da. of ye 1st mo 1719 W^m Hunt late of Byberry produced a certificate from Radnor in Great Britain which was read and accepted."

Radnor is a border county (in England) of Wales and lies north of Cardiff about half way north and south of the Welsh border. It is west of Worcestershire.

Falls mtg minutes shows a W^m Hunt arriving by certificate from Abington mtg ^{6.5} 1719

"3rd of 12 mo. 1719 Falls Mtg declares that W^m Hunt proposes his intentions of marriage with Mary Woolman belonging to Burlington Mtg. It being the first time the mtg appoints Samuel Beaks and John Hutchinson to inquire into Williams clearness and report.

Burlington Min. 1. 17. 1719-20 the marriage of W^m Hunt and Mary Woolman was allowed. He producing a certificate of clearness from Falls Mtg.

Falls Mtg. Min. 11. 5. 1725 "W^m Hunt's conversation having been such that Truth hath been dishonored thereby for which he hath been dealt with several times by the Falls overseers; but their advice taking no effect, he still continuing in disorderly practices, therefore agreed that Thos. Watson, John Lotcher, Geo. Clough & W^m Atkinson do draw a paper of condemnation between now and next meeting."

"Falls Mtg. 12. 2. 1725" The Friends appointed to draw a testimony against W^m Hunt accordingly have done so and brought it to this meeting; which was read and approved and ordered to be read publicly by Thomas Watson on next First Day at Falls Mtg. House after meeting."

After the parents death - From other sources it seems both died about 1745 - the children were scattered.

Thomas was married prior to 1752. Probably in Md. and in Prince Georges Co. since he m.

Cleaver was 27 in 1752 when he married so I take it that
